The ambiance was awesome — dark wood, beautifully stocked bar, library themed details. All in all very comfortable.

The selection of single malts is good, and the bartenders very friendly.

I ordered the Grass Fed Beef Burger and it was excellent — complete with a pickle speared to the top of the burger and fries dusted with coarse salt and a small shaker of vinegar.

For sports there's a giant screen & HD projector, as well as a handful of flat panels lining the bar.

Cock & Bull is a great respite in an otherwise dreary dead-zone of cookie cutter pubs.
